INFORMATION ON EXPERIMENTS AT TA-33

H-1

1. Experiment carried out at 12:22 P.M.
2. Almost clear sky with scattered thin cloud streaks at high altitude.
3. Ground wind before experiment from south at 5 mph.
4. Immediately after experiment wind direction from south but as cloud reached 200 ft. the wind shifted and came from southwest. Cloud had dispersed in about seven minutes after experiment.
5. Readings taken in area after experiment with a portable sniffer (old type) gave a reading of 6 divisions on #5 scale, and area still contained a quantity of smoke from debris.
