RADIATION SURVEY OF OLD HOT POINT, TA-33

H-1

Following the bulldozing operation at Old Hot Point at TA-33 on October 21, 1953, a radiation survey was made on the area at Chamber #2 and no radioactive contamination could be detected. Therefore, the area can now be declared a clean area and, from a radiological standpoint, the area is safe to again be entered freely, and construction may begin if you so desire.

The contamination that had been in the area has been reduced by normal decay and some will be buried under a heavy layer of dirt in the area. If the new construction requires a basement, you should proceed with caution and have the area checked during operation; otherwise, no special precautions will have to be taken during construction.
