EXPERIMENT AT TA-33 ON NOVEMBER 19, 1953

The experiment was carried out at 1500. The wind was to the southwest at approximately 5 miles per hour. There was a low cloud cover and light snowfall at the time.

The cloud rose slowly and moved to the southwest. It was soon lost to sight as it blended with the clouds.

The meter reading was zero except at the impact point where there was a reading of 10 on the 5 scale. Another reading here 10 minutes later was zero.
