The experiment was triggered at 1445 on December 3, 1953. There was a surface wind of 3 to 5 miles an hour, east to west. No snow was falling but clouds were rather low.

The smoke cloud traveled slowly from east to west, and at the first observation was at about 800 ft. and rising slowly.

There was no indication on the meter at any point.

The smoke cloud was lost due to the clouds, but from the movement of the clouds, I believe the smoke cloud must have reversed direction and traveled to the east.
