Dear Mr. Taylor and Dr. Browne:

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has completed the Administrative Completeness Review of the Voluntary Corrective Action (VCA) Plan for potential release sites (PRSs) 33-007(b), 33-010(c), and C-33-003 (EM/ER:99-100 and LA-UR-[pending]). The VCA Plan is dated April 27, 1999 and was received by HRMB on April 27, 1999. The document has been determined to be Administratively Complete and a fee of \$750 is assessed for continued review of this document. The work sheet used for calculation of your Document Review Fee is attached. (Please note, C-33-003 is not listed in Module VIII of the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for Los Alamos National Laboratory and, therefore, was not assessed a fee.)

Payment is due within sixty (60) days of receipt of this letter. Should the Return Receipt be sent back to us without a date, receipt of the fees are due sixty (60) days from the date of this letter. **Payment should be made by certified check or money order payable to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Permits Fund 339.** Should you need to request an extension of the sixty (60) day period the request must be received by HRMB a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty (60) day period. This fourteen (14) day period will be necessary to ensure that the facility receives written approval prior to the expiration of the sixty (60) day payment period.



Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20 NMAC 4.2.302.1.

Upon receipt of the fee, HRMB staff will initiate the processing of the VCA Plan in accordance with the time line established in 20 NMAC 4.2.201.7. This regulatory language states that " NMED shall review and approve or disapprove a corrective action document within one-hundred eighty (180) days after the document is accepted for review by NMED and the applicable fee has been assessed and paid. The Secretary may allow an additional sixty (60) days for review upon a determination that good cause exists for the additional review time. The review period set by this subsection shall be tolled during all periods in which NMED is awaiting a response by the facility to a Request for Supplemental Information or a Notice of Deficiency and during all time periods in which further action cannot be taken due to public hearing requirements."
