SUBJECT: Disposal of plutonium contaminated sodium loops from Ten Site

SYMBOL :

Ten Site(K-2) has five plutonium contaminated sodium loops which they wish to get rid of in the contaminated dump. I recently went to Ten Site to discuss the disposal operation with Tony Garcia, H-1, Fred Rossiter, Eng-4, and George Meadows, K-2.

It was decided that these loops should be placed into disposal wells in Area C. The Riggers will be asked to move the loops(which weigh about 200 pounds, each) to the disposal well and gently lower them into the well. Each loop is then to be covered with fresh concrete and a foot thick layer of concrete is to be placed on top of the last loop in the hole. This should provide a fairly permanent seal for these items.

As fresh cement has been requested for this operation I asked Rossiter to order enough more to plug four filled disposal wells also(filled means up to within three feet of ground level).
