The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed a technical review of Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) RCRA Voluntary Corrective Action (VCA) Completion Report for cleanup activities in Technical Area (TA) 36, Potential Release Site (PRS) C-36-001, dated January 19, 1996. The PRS is a test containment vessel, which was contaminated with plutonium. RCRA constituents were found during the VCA.
