Subject: Notification of tetrachloroethene (PERC) in R-20 and R-21

James and David, this message is to notify you that LANL staff has just discovered concentrations of tetrachloroethene (PERC) in groundwater from each of three ports in R-20 and the single screened well R-21 located in the regional aquifer. The detection limit is 0.25 ug/L and measured concentrations are 3.0, 0.38, 0.32, and 0.26 ug/L, respectively. The samples were taken between July 6 and July 8, 2006. The highest value is 61% of the EPA MCL of 5 ug/L. At this time, we do not know the source of tetrachloroethene and the results have been validated. We will contact you again when we have more information about this matter. Please do not distribute this information until this time. Thank you.

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
