

Subject: Fifteen-Day Sampling Notification North Ancho Canyon Aggregate Area Investigation/Remediation

Beginning February 4, 2009, Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory) is scheduled to begin investigation and remediation activities in the North Ancho Canyon Aggregate Area. The scope of the sampling contained in this extensive field campaign is documented in the Investigation Work Plan for the North Ancho Aggregate Area, Revision 1, dated December 2007 (EP2007-0762), and the subsequent New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Approval with Modifications for this Work Plan, dated December 21, 2007 (HWB-LANL-07-028).

Sampling and remediation activities are expected to last for 3 months, from February to April 2009. The Laboratory will notify NMED staff of any changes to the schedule. The sampling results will be presented in the investigation report for this aggregate area, due to NMED on July 31, 2009.
