It appears that sampling of the main aquifer test wells at TA-49 has been indefinitely delayed due to access problems. The lead problem associated with DT-5A is a continuing concern of the NMED. The NMED/AIP believes that sampling and time interval Pb testing should have already been completed. NMED/AIP recommends sampling the subject well as soon as possible, and request that LANL provide a specified sampling date.
