**Subject: Request to Abandon Borehole 50-24817 at Material Disposal Area C,
Solid Waste Management Unit 50-009**

Dear Mr. Kieling:


This letter requests approval to abandon borehole 50-24817 at Material Disposal Area (MDA) C at Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory) Technical Area 50. This borehole is located within a paved area north of the MDA C fence and was originally advanced to a depth of 250 ft below ground surface (bgs) during the 2005 investigation of MDA C. During the 2008 Phase II investigation at MDA C, this borehole was advanced to a depth of 450 ft bgs. The Laboratory attempted to complete this borehole as a vapor-monitoring well by installing a Flexible Liner Underground Technology (FLUTE) system. However, difficulties were encountered with installation of the FLUTE system, and this approach was abandoned. Instead, a new borehole, 50-606383, was installed to a depth of 450 ft bgs at a location approximately 10 ft from borehole 50-24817. Borehole 50-603383 was completed as a vapor-monitoring well with stainless-steel sampling ports. A protective surface casing was installed on borehole 50-24817, and this borehole is no longer used monitoring purposes.

Recently, the protective surface casing on borehole 50-24817 was damaged by snow removal equipment. Because this borehole is no longer used for monitoring, the Laboratory wishes to abandon it rather than repair the surface casing. This borehole would be abandoned by injecting cement grout from the bottom of the borehole using a tremie pipe.
