Total for 1956 to September 7, 1956: 1591.916 cubic yards. The above figures were derived by determining the volume in cubic inches of the 13" x 13" x 21" box used for trash disposal. This volume was multiplied by the number of boxes buried per quarter. This figure was then divided by 46,656 (number of cubic inches in one cubic yard).

For barrels the number of cubic yards was determined by multiplying the number of barrels buried by .368 (number of cubic yards in one barrel).
