DUMPS FOR CONTAMINATED WASTE

H-1

The proposal by Security to use the contaminated waste pit - Area C - for disposal of unburnable classified waste is satisfactory to H-1, with the following considerations:

Pit 6 which is now being used for contaminated waste disposal still has considerable usable space which I feel should be used for contaminated waste. Also we plan to use the new pit - Area G, Pit 2 - for burning portions of M Building and do not want to use it for regular contaminated waste until the demolition of M Building is completed. However, we are willing to make available the west end of Pit 5, Area C. This is approximately 2000 cubic yards of pit space. The east end of this pit is used by CHB for the disposal of chemicals, but this should not interfere with Security using the west end.

If it is decided that Security will use Pit 5 it should be understood that access will be controlled by H-1 and that a gate key will not be issued to them. Also the arrangements and expense for coverage should be the responsibility of Security.
