Recently, Group H-1 has provided a section of Contaminated Pit Area No. 6 to be used as a Laboratory Chemical Disposal Area by myself and James Stearns.

It is proposed that this section in the southwest corner of Pit No. 6 become the permanent chemical disposal area for at least the next ten years. A fence should be constructed to partition off this southwest corner section from the rest of Pit No. 6 and one disposal pit should be provided along the north side of the newly fenced area. This pit should be approximately 12 feet deep, 10 feet wide, and 60 feet long, and the dirt should be piled along the north side of the pit.

A one inch water line should be provided with a valve and faucet to fit a garden hose at a location in the southwest corner of the area. This will provide a source of water for reacting with some chemicals, for first aid fire control, and for use in an emergency. This water line should be installed in a way that will prevent its freezing during cold weather. A small tool shed should be provided for storage of emergency equipment and tools, since the disposal of some chemicals is a hazardous operation. A weather-proof telephone should be installed near the gate to this area for use in an emergency.

Since this is to be a permanent area, it is requested that future budget funds be requested for covering small sections of the pit from time to time, and to construct other pits in this area as required.
