SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL WASTE DISPOSAL WELLS IN AREA C

SYMBOL : H-1

In the next three months, H-1 will need more disposal wells in Area C. To enable us to make maximum use of the area, I request that the Engineering Department prepare a plan of the area indicating the optimum location for waste disposal wells.

The diameter and location of the wells should be such that they can be reached by a truck without driving over filled areas or wells. Since the wells are used for the disposal of fissionable material, there must be at least three feet between the edges of the holes. The USGS has approved depths up to sixty feet. Because of criticality limitations, it is not economical to drill some of the wells deeper than twenty feet.

Estimated requirements for the next two years are:

- 10 wells 3 feet diameter, 20 feet deep
- 10 wells 2 feet diameter, 60 feet deep
- 15 wells 3 feet 6 inches diameter, 60 feet deep
