SUBJECT: WASTE DISPOSAL WELLS, AREA C

Please write the following work order to ENG-4:

1. Drill 10 disposal wells at waste disposal site, Area C. Start with stake #56 and continue through stake #65. Wells are to be 2 feet in diameter and approximately 20 feet deep.
2. Furnish and place 4' x 4' x 3/4" wooden covers on above holes.
3. Furnish and place at each corner of wooden covers 6' steel fence posts. Posts are to be driven into the ground about 12 to 15 inches.
4. Furnish and attach to the fence posts around each well a chain. Chain is to be about size 16, single-jack type; one strand of chain for each well; chain to be 4' above ground.
5. Contact John Enders, H-1 (7-4093), for entrance to area and Rad-Safe instructions.
