SUBJECT: FUTURE LAND USE CONTROL - CHEMICAL DISPOSAL AREA, PAJARITO ROAD AND TEN-SITE ROAD INTERSECTION (Area C)

This office will close out the referenced disposal area by July 1, 1964. We will place approximately 200 gas cylinders which are full or partially full in this dump then cover the cylinders with approximately 10 feet of compacted fill. I would like for this letter to be attached to engineering drawings of this area as a warning to those who in the future may plan to use this area for any purpose whatsoever.

I realize that this particular area lies between two long contaminated trenches long since filled and that the area will be restricted for future use. However, any exploratory drilling must not be permitted and this disposal area should be clearly defined on your drawings.
