SUBJECT: Status of Area "C"

The purpose of this memo is to inform you that C. O. Martinez and myself have dirt filled and cement capped five holes in area "C". These holes were: number 55(24 inch diameter), number 96 and 97(36 inch diameter), and holes number 100 and 102(12 inch diameter).

The 36 inch holes took 9 bags of cement each, the 24 inch hole took 6 bags, and the 12 inch holes took two each. Therefore 28 bags of cement were used.(This leaves us 22 bags at T.A.-50 and two bags at area "G".)

The total operation took approximately 12 man-hours labor to complete. (Three man-hours of this was preparation and equipment repair and adjustment.)

The cement mixer and other mixing equipment was left at area "C" due to the fact that the large truck was unavailable to transport it back to area "G". (The remaining cement was returned to T.A.-50.)

The Onan M.G. set was returned to T.A.-50.

Therefore, the only holes in area "C" that are not filled and capped are: holes 103, 104, and 105(all 12 inch diameter) and holes 89(36 inch dia. hole that is half-full of pipe from "N"division) and 93(36 inch diameter hole half-full of animal tissue.).

IT is suggested that when the mixing equipment is moved to area "G" that the hole liner and lid that was removed from hole 55 be taken to area "G" also.
