Dear Mr. Drypolcher:

Pursuant to your request of November 26, 1985, the following information must be submitted to the EID for review before interim status may be authorized for the incinerator. This information is required by Section 206.C.10., of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-2).

1. If the wastes to be incinerated are hazardous solely because they are ignitable, reactive, or corrosive, then Los Alamos only needs to provide documentation that the wastes are not expected to contain any of the hazardous waste constituents listed in 201.C. Appendix III.
2. If the wastes to be incinerated contain any of the Appendix III constituents or are hazardous for reasons other than ignitable, corrosive, or reactive, then Los Alamos needs to provide waste analyses that identifies the heating value of the waste; the halogen and sulfur content of the waste; and, the concentrations of lead and mercury in the waste. Los Alamos will also need to provide a copy of the inspection schedule.
