I am concerned about the Los Alamos radioactive and hazardous waste incinerator for reasons of health and safety.

If the Environmental Improvement Division is interested in improvement, it will issue an emergency order by the authority of the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act, section 74-2-10, to prevent the burning of radioactive waste until the state can adopt standards in a public forum to regulate it.

Any hearings the EID holds should include both the hazardous and radioactive permits. It is a real show of lack of common sense not to.
