Learning of the public hearing on July 18, I feel impelled to write to tell you that the people I know in Santa Fe do not want to have any waste incinerated by the Los Alamos Lab.

We do not want the EID to issue any permit for incinerating any toxic waste into our air and water.

We are disturbed that Los Alamos has been exempt from State regulation in view of the abysmal record of the DOE and the NRC in protecting public health and safety.

We understand that Los Alamos Laboratory has already incinerated radioactive waste without informing the public, and we feel that ~~any~~ any permit to incinerate is a foot in the door for the lab to ignore public health and safety.

We need much more public input into the regulatory process.
