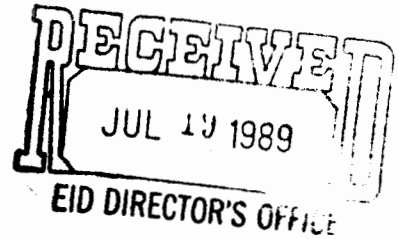

Dear Mr. Mitzelfelter:

Radioactive waste is a major problem and no solution is possible until the government and private industry STOPS producing this lethal waste.

Studies, which the government will not recognize, prove the disastrous effect low levels of radioactive waste has on the environment and living creatures - humans included. In light of the recent revelations about the misinformation produced by the DOE, and by burning the waste at LANL it will create a more concentrated and more lethal form of hazardous and radioactive waste. We demand that the EID issue an emergency order (by authority of the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act section 74-2-10) to prevent the burning of radioactive and hazardous waste until the State can adopt standards in a public forum to regulate it.

Please act in the interest of the private citizens of this State whom you are suppose to protect.
