This is in response to your letter of September 18, 1989 which indicated that you are unable to accept the Eight Northern Indian Pueblos Council Position Paper relative to the Los Alamos National Laboratory's application on the Incineration of Hazardous Wastes.

Should you question the validity of approval or support from the ENIPC Northern Pueblo Governors, the attached resolution is documentation in support of the draft statement.
