This letter is to inform you of the upcoming geophysical event that affects the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Facility Investigation work being performed in Operable Unit 1147 at Los Alamos National Laboratory.

A high-resolution magnetometry survey will be performed of the 12-acre materials disposal area C in preparation for drilling beneath the landfill to be performed in 1995. The survey will be performed by a team from Sandia National Laboratory, the Naval Research Laboratory, and GeoCenters Inc. with an innovative towed array of magnetometers that can gather data and position extremely rapidly.

The survey is planned for August 22. It may continue on August 23 if necessary. We will keep you and/or your designated representative apprised of the progress should you desire to observe this operation.
