Dear Mr. Kirkman:

We are in receipt of your letter of February 8, 1996, regarding termination of Los Alamos National Laboratory's (LANL) approval to dispose of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) in its Controlled Air Incinerator (CAI). This letter serves as notice of termination of the CAI PCB incinerator approval issued to the Department of Energy (DOE) on October 9, 1992, pursuant to Section 6(e) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA). The termination notice shall be effective on the date of this letter.

In your letter, you included a closure/decontamination plan for the CAI unit. We have reviewed this plan, and have determined that the plan is adequate for the closure/decontamination of the CAI unit. Closure activities shall be completed within 180 days of the date of this letter. Certification of closure by an independent registered professional engineer shall be submitted to EPA Region 6 within 60 days of completion of closure.
