SUBJECT: Spill Clean-up Resolution on TA-50 Pump House Storm Water Spill of 8/29/2005

Dear Mr. Turner:

On August 8, 2005, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) was notified of a construction site storm water spill that occurred at the pump house construction site at TA-50 located at Los Alamos National Laboratory, Los Alamos, New Mexico as required by 20.6.2.1203 NMAC of the Water Quality Control Commission. The spill was approximately 18,000 gallons of storm water.

Based on the review of the spill response action report received on September 9, 2005, by NMED's SWQB and DOE OB, the response was adequate and no further action is required at this time. However, this NMED joint-Bureau correspondence does not relieve the United States Department of Energy or the University of California, of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
