Pit #6, Area G, TA-54, is currently in use for disposal of above subject material. Observations over the past years indicate the normal length of time a pit may be used is about two years. However, Pit #6 is now being filled at an accelerated rate due to the current LASL and Zia Company clean up activities and demolition activities at DP East.

It would appear advisable to start planning for another pit within the next two years. Although space is available along the south edge of Pit #6, the dirt stockpile for Pit #6 is located here. In order to have another pit available before Pit #6 is filled, an additional area would have to be cleared, the pit dug and additional fencing put up around it before it could be put into use.
