SUBJECT: DEMPSTER DUMPSTER DELIVERIES TO TA-54

A review of the deliveries to Area G, TA-54, during 1971 has been made and it indicates that it might be possible to schedule deliveries to one or twice per week.

Scrap deliveries would be more difficult to control as they are usually the result of work orders placed by ENG-4 at any Site generating radioactive waste.


Sludge drums from TA-50 are delivered almost daily to Pit #8, Area G. The present capacity at TA-50 for storing drums filled with sludge is limited to two skip Dempster Dumpsters.

A tabulation was made of Dempster Dumpsters delivered to TA-54 during 1971. The first column shows the number of times each Dumpster was emptied and the second column indicates the weekly average frequency of unloading. As expected, BLDG. #2, South Side, DP West and Dock #5, Sigma, are the two most frequently emptied Dumpsters.

A tabulation of scrap disposal, starting with 1960 shows an average of 3,058 yd.³ per year.

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
