SUBJECT : EROSION CONTROL AND SOIL FIXATION AT AREA G, TA-54

As of now, no further waste disposal operations are planned for the portion of Area G, TA-54, which contains pits #1 through 5. The final covering of pit #5 with previously excavated tuff will be completed within one week. This entire area, consisting of about 12 acres, is shown on the attached map.

The Waste Management Section would like to initiate a program for this part of Area G to establish needed improvements in erosion control and soil fixation. It is recognized that much of the early work may be experimental in nature, testing different possible concepts or techniques


To establish an initial program plan we request that in the next few weeks, you take a close look at the designated area, and formulate possible courses of action that can be tried or tested. It would be appreciated if these proposals could be submitted to the Waste Management Section by April 26. Shortly thereafter, if necessary, a meeting of all interested parties will be called to discuss and select the initial work to be done.
