SUBJECT : ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING DISPOSAL SHAFTS AND PITS  
AT AREA G, TA-54

In reply to several questions you asked on above subject, the following information is offered:

I. When was cell #1 closed and when was cell #2 put in use in Pit #9?

Enough TRU-R material, in crates and drums, had accrued by the time Pit #9 was ready so that cell #1 and the south portion of cell #2 were stacked at the same time.

This work (stacking crates and drums) started on 11/25/74. On 12/17/74, cell #1 was covered with plastic sheeting and plywood and on 12/20/74, crushed tuff was placed over cell #1.

On 7/11/75, additional crushed tuff was placed in between cell #1 and #2 as well as over the south portion of cell #2.

II. There was no "formal" decision made to redesignate the "H-1 Decon Pit" to Pit#19 (for exclusive use to receive the H-5 waste from Wg 4 Bsmt,. SM-29).

The decision was made informally by John Warren, H-7, by a memo issued in the Spring of 1975 to H. Hidy, ENG-3.

III. Pit 7 should receive "final" dirt cover by the first week in March, 1976.

IV. The first delivery to Pit #24 was on July 3, 1975.

V. The first cask was loaded in Trench B on 3/25/74 (Cask #81). This Trench is still in use (as of 3/1/76). Casks #100 through #68 and #66 have been loaded. There are 67 empty casks remaining in Trench B.

Filled casks in Trench B were covered with dirt on 12/17/75.

Trench A was filled by 10/29/74 and the trench was covered in November, 1974.

(Note): Both trenches were excavated in December, 1973.

VI. Dates of first deliveries to:

1. Shaft #51 - - 2/27/75
2. Shaft #52 - - 9/8/75
3. Shaft #53 - - 11/20/75
4. Shaft #80 - - 6/3/75
5. Shaft #81 - - 5/16/75

VII. Shaft #75 received its last delivery on 10/12/73. On 11/21/73, I have a note on my calendar pad that states "2 loads of Ready Mix to be delivered to plug 5 disposal shafts - - ". I believe this Shaft (#75) was plugged at that time.

VIII. The date of the last delivery to Shaft #51 was on 10/2/75. We plan to seal this shaft this month (March, 1976).

Shaft #52 still has some remaining space which indicates it will probably be filled and sealed within the next six months.
