Cheryl Rofer told me Wednesday that EPA will be notified of a small quantity of water found in hole #24-1015, the first of two angled holes to be drilled beneath MDA L. (Court - this relates to your 12/28/94 response to my original message). Only a small quantity of water accumulated over the holidays, but there was enough collected to send for chem analysis. The remainder was blown free in the air stream from the air rotary drill rig. The sample was taken from the discharge from the rig, not from a bailer or monitor well (the water was unexpected when the crew re-started drilling after the holiday break). Portable instruments (PID) did not detect volatile organics.

Cheryl knows of Barbara Driscoll's request to report water encountered in new bore holes, but was there a timeframe for reporting in her request? I asked Cheryl to report the water to Barbara ASAP in the event that EPA would want to sample the water, if even possible.

I also asked her if NMED has a similar notification requirement, and she said she didn't know. Does NMED also need to be notified?

I could use your input on answering the above two questions. Thanks!!
