On May 7, 2004 the NMED issued a Public Notice with the intent to approve the closure plans for six interim status storage units at Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). NMED is rescinding the Public Notice and its intent to approve the Closure Plan for Storage Shafts 145 and 146. NMED does not intend to take action on the Closure Plan for these two interim status units at this time.

LANL is owned by the U.S. Department of Energy and is co-operated by the University of California. 
