John,

We received your sampling notification for the three boreholes required by the Supplemental Investigation Work Plan. A couple of things:

- 1) The table does not include the pore-gas sampling requirements for the three boreholes. The table needs to be revised to include the pore-gas sampling (particularly the analyses). Once revised, it can be sent via email.
- 2) Section III.O of the March 1, 2005 Consent Order (Order) requires that the Permittees notify NMED in writing or by email or fax of any field sampling activities undertaken pursuant to any plan or requirement of the Order a minimum of 15 days prior to the sampling activity. The sampling notification was dated January 26, 2007 and stated that sampling activities were scheduled to begin January 30, 2007 (4 days). In the future, the Permittees must ensure that sampling notifications are submitted on time or the Permittees may be subject to an enforcement action.
