Rebecca,

This e-mail is to provide answers to the questions you asked me by telephone on Wednesday.

Trailer TA-54-439 (FRAM) was placed on Pad 10 approximately June 2004. It was included with the list of trailers in the April 2009 closure plan for Pad 10. It is no longer active but still at Pad 10 pending salvage. The Super HENC trailer (TA-54-547) will be sited in approximately the same location as shown in the new Fig. 31.

The MOVER trailer unit arrived at LANL in 2005 and has been inactive at Pad 10 since. It will be sited at Pad 1 as described and begin to manage waste there. As shown on the new Fig. 29, there are two trailers - the MOVER itself and a support trailer that won't manage waste. They have recently been assigned structure numbers TA-54-575 and TA-54-576.

Your point that this is more correctly described as the placement of the MOVER on Pad 1 for waste management purposes rather than a transfer from Pad 10 is appropriate. The trailer was not active while at Pad 10 and hadn't been assigned a structure number. Our language was describing the physical event and not the RCRA context.
