John Kieling:

I am writing to urge you to deny the NMED permit to LANL for the Class 2 permit modification to add a hazardous waste container storage unit to the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Facility Permit. This is for future wastes. There are already too many radioactive wastes at LANL. The production of additional transuranic wastes at LANL is not safe and threatens our water supply, including the Rio Grande, which now provides water for the city of Santa Fe.

LANL's safety record regarding contaminants and radioactive materials has not been good. Production of new radioactive wastes is unacceptable. It is dangerous and unnecessary. I want funding for CMRR-NF cut and construction stopped. It is also hugely expensive. Instead, fund clean up. Please call on LANL to clean up current contamination and ask Congress to fund the clean up. Thank you.
