Neelam,

We would like to apply a tarp over exposed waste as it is relocated to serve as a protective daily cover in lieu of 6-inches of soil. We believe this would be a more manageable and economic choice for several reasons. We have limited quality soil and wish to conserve that as final cover soil. We are most worried about the potential for infiltration after part of the asphalt cover is removed for solid waste placement, prior to the new ET cover installation. We believe that an impermeable tarp would prevent infiltration into the waste or subgrade materials. The tarps would be secured with sand bags each night. We don't expect the tarps to have to be used but a few days. We would like to make you aware of this request ASAP for your concurrence. Thanks for your help in this matter.
