Thanks for the response. We have an appointment with Los Alamos County on 4/20/04, and will know more then. I also thought about the option of moving the waste to one end of the landfill, then excavating the landfill deeper so that when the waste is moved back, spread out, and covered with an E-T cover the elevation of the end product cover is level with the airstrip so as not to pose problems for future use as airplane hangers and tie downs. Will need to look at the cost differential. Just thinking out loud.

Bob,

As a follow-up to our conversation yesterday, I wanted let you know a few things. I talked with Ed Hansen and we both believe that DOE is allowed to move waste from the east end of the airport landfill and dispose of it off-site instead of within the SWMU boundaries under the following conditions:

1. DOE must submit to NMED a plan that describes how it will excavate and characterize the waste to be disposed off-site. The plan must include DOE's anticipated erosion control activities.
2. All waste must be analyzed for VOCs, SVOCs, TAL metals, radionuclides, PCBs/pesticides, dioxins/furan, and perchlorate. DOE must also collect QA/QC samples.
3. The waste should be segregated on-site in a manner protective of the environment (details of this should be in plan), and should be disposed of following receipt of the analytical data.
4. Waste may be moved off-site for disposal only after the analytical results have been submitted and reviewed by NMED. NMED will notify DOE of the data's acceptability.

This list is by no means comprehensive of what should be in your plan. It merely highlights some important aspects. Please let me know DOE's anticipated schedule for delivering this document and performing the work.
