Thanks for the call back this morning.
Section 5.1.11 of the work plan for *Corrective Action of SWMU 73-002 and Investigation fof Consolidated Unit 73-002-99* mentions use of an All-Terrain Excavator as one of the methods to be used during ash and debris removal activities. A formal request to deviate from the workplan to include the ATE does not appear to be necessary and may be confusing. The Investigation Report will address all field work activities including the ATE which I believe is the appropriate format. Your phone message this morning indicated that you agree with this approach. Unless I hear otherwise from NMED, I'm not planning on sending the request to employ the ATE as it is already addressed.

Ground crews begin field work next week (Sept 26) followed by the sky-line lift and the ATE on the week of Oct 2. Let me know if you, or any of your associates, are interested in a site visit during the removal phase.
