Dear Mr. Roy,

Please announce over the radio, between 7:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Friday through Thursday, between April 23 and April 29, 1993, the following public service announcement:

**It is being proposed by the State of New Mexico's Environment Department that Cannon Air Force Base, owner and operator of the Melrose Air Force Bombing Range, be denied the granting of a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act permit for the Base's failure to provide complete information necessary to conduct a technical evaluation. The permit was for a hazardous waste management treatment unit on the Melrose Range.**

**Along with denial of the permit, Cannon Air Force Base would lose their interim status that allowed them to manage hazardous waste since 1980 at the Melrose Range. This proposal is not associated with permitted hazardous waste storage on base at Cannon.**

Information regarding this decision may be reviewed at the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau of the New Mexico Environment, located at 525 Camino de los Marquez in Santa Fe.
