The New Mexico Environment Department completed an administrative completeness review of the 1993 Melrose Air Force Range (MAFR), Open Detonation Unit, Part B Permit application. The Part B Permit application of September 17, 1993 is an entirely new application, not to be confused with the 1990 Part B Permit application. As agreed between the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB), the new Permit application was to have been administratively complete upon submission in order for interim status to be maintained at the MAFR. The Permit application has been determined to be administratively complete in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Regulations (HWMR-7), Part IX, §270.10(c).

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (HWFR-1) require that Permit fees be assessed when all information is received that satisfy administrative completeness of a Permit application. The fee for the MAFR Open Detonation Unit is \$19,000; a statement and work sheet are enclosed. In accordance with the intent of HWFR-1, a primary consideration in assessing Permit fees is the amount of staff time involved in each permitting function.

#### Public Participation Fee

A public participation fee of \$4,000 is charged to all hazardous waste management permit applicants. This fee is included because in response to increasing levels of public interest in the permitting process, NMED automatically facilitates public information meeting(s) in communities potentially affected by the issuance of permits.

#### Basic Permit Fee

A basic permit fee of \$10,000 is charged for review of numerous conditions common to all permits. These conditions are required to be incorporated into all permits by HWMR-7, Part V, §264; and Part IX, §270.

Unit Fee

A Unit fee of \$5,000 is charged for review of numerous conditions unique to each hazardous waste management unit. Required conditions for each unit are established in HWMR-7, Part V, §264; and Part IX, §270.

Review of the application for technical adequacy will begin upon receipt of the Permit fees. We intend to complete the technical review portion of the permitting process prior to December 31, 1993. Failure to pay the fees within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter may result in a Permit denial.
