Dear Mr. Vohs:

Please announce over the radio (all 3 of your stations), between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday, August 8 through August 12, 1994, the following public service announcement. Any additional announcements will be appreciated:

The New Mexico Environment Department in Santa Fe is considering granting a RCRA or Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, hazardous waste facility permit to Cannon Air Force Base for treatment of military waste explosives by open detonation at the Melrose Air Force Bombing and Gunnery Range. The Range is located about 25 miles west of Cannon Air Force Base near the town of Melrose.

Detailed information on this activity is available in a draft copy of the permit. The draft Permit and a fact sheet are available locally at the Clovis Carver Public Library in Clovis and at Portales Public Library in Portales.

The public is invited to review and submit comments on the draft Permit to the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau of the New Mexico Environment Department. Comments must be received during a 45 day period, beginning August 8 and ending September 21. The address to send comments is 525 Camino de los Marques, Post Office Box 26110, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Attention, Ms. Barbara Hoditschek.

A representative from New Mexico Environment Department will also be available next week on Wednesday August 17, 1994 at the Clovis-Carver Public Library. If you wish to have your questions answered in person about this proposal, stop by the library during the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
