This letter constitutes the fourth quarter's progress report (Oct - Dec 99) by Sec F, Module IV, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit for Melrose Air Force Range, New Mexico.

In November, representatives of Cannon, New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), the Corps of Engineers and the contractor held a conference call to discuss NMED's expectations for a Request for Supplemental Information on the RCRA Facility Investigation Draft Report. With the funds available, it was decided to gauge the monitoring wells to see which had water and Cannon would propose a further round of sampling subject to NMED approval.

Projected RCRA Corrective Actions Program Activities for the first quarter of 2000 (Jan - Mar 00) are the formulation of a sampling plan and response to the Request for Supplemental Information.
