This letter constitutes the first quarter's progress report (Jan-Mar 00) by Sec F, Module IV, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit for Melrose Air Force Range, New Mexico.

During the first quarter of 2000, Cannon AFB in cooperation with the Corps of Engineers and our contractor came up with a plan to accomplish another round of groundwater sampling at Melrose Range.

Projected RCRA Corrective Actions Program Activities for the second quarter are another round of groundwater sampling and delivery of the results to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED). Cannon AFB will consult with NMED prior to sampling to ensure there is agreement on the parameters in the sampling plan.
