This letter is the first quarter (Jan-Mar 03) Progress Report as required per Section F, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit for Melrose Air Force Range (MAFR), Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the first quarter of CY03 are as follows:

- a. The final report for the Ecological Risk Assessment Addendum for the MAFR Request For Information was completed.
- b. The next investigative stage of the hydrogeologic study for the MAFR was completed.
- c. US Geological Services collected water samples in support of the hydrogeologic study at MAFR. No explosive chemical constituents were found in the analytical data.
- d. Three copies of the Final RCRA Facility Investigation Report Addendum for MAFR dated Feb 03 were delivered to your office 4 Mar.
