This letter is the fourth quarter CY 06 (Oct-Dec) Progress Report for Solid Waste Management Units existing on Cannon Air Force Base as required per Paragraph 2.5.3.d (Quarterly Reports) of the Hazardous Waste Permit (EPA ID No. NM7572124454) issued to Cannon AFB October 17, 2003 and SWMUs located on Melrose Air Force Range.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the fourth quarter of 2006 are as follows:

- a. Submitted Final Accelerated Corrective Measures Work Plan Addendum for the Removal of Contaminated Soil for Fire Training Area 04 (SWMU 109) in preparation for no further action submittal.
- b. Submitted Groundwater sampling of Melrose Air Force Range.
- c. Petitioned for Indefinite Work Plan for MAFR to NMED's office due to the fact that it is an active range.
- c. Submitted Groundwater sampling of Sewage Lagoons and Landfill 5.
- d. Submitted Final RCRA Facility Investigation for 21 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMU)
- e. URS completed Final Corrective Measures Implementation Work Plan for site SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90) in response to your letter dated 21 Nov 2006.
- f. HydroGeoLogic, Inc. performed ground water sampling at Landfills 3, and 4 in November from sampling wells Ra, Na and Oa respectively.
- g. The U.S. Geological Service (USGS) continued to collect groundwater data as part of the RCAP at CAFB and MAFR and in support of a hydrogeologic study of MAFR and surrounding area on Dec 18, 19, 20 and 21, 2006.
- h. 34 Sites came off the Hazardous Waste Permit on 31 Dec 06.

Projected RCAP activities for the first quarter of 2007:

- a. Groundwater sampling will continue to be collected and evaluated by USGS in support of the CAFB and MAFR hydrogeologic study.
- b. The Restoration Advisory board is attentively scheduled to meet at 7:00 pm, April 5, 2007 at the Clovis Carver Library in Clovis, NM.
