

Dear Mr. Bearzi

This is the first quarter CY 08 (Jan-Mar) Progress Report for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) on Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) and Melrose Air Force Range (MAFR), as required per paragraph 2.5.3.d (Quarterly Reports) of the Hazardous Waste Permit (Environmental Protection Agency, Identification Number New Mexico 7572124454) issued to Cannon AFB on 17 Oct 03.

Activities for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the first quarter of 2008 are as follows:

- a. CAFB submitted the *Final Work Plan Addendum, RCRA Facility Investigation for SWMU's 34, 78, 85, 91, 95, and 107*, dated February 2008, for NMED's review and approval.
- b. CAFB paid the invoice for New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB)-CAFB-07-003 to provide technical review for *ST-26 (SWMU 48A) and Area Of Concern 36 Corrective Measures Implementation Work Plan*, dated August 2007.
- c. CAFB received additional guidance from NMED for Long Term Monitoring (LTM) sampling and analysis for Landfill (LF) -03, LF-04, LF-25 and SWMU-101 on 26 March 2008. The base shall submit a LTM Work Plan, perform and document landfill inspections, as well as, analyze for VOCs, Priority Pollutant metals, barium, nitrate, and perchlorate.

Projected RCAP activities for the first quarter of 2008: The contracts for groundwater sampling, LTM, at CAFB and MAFR are undergoing revision to reflect NMED's current guidance. LTM reports and inspections will be forward to NMED by 31 Dec 08.
