Subject: Request for Second Extension of Time for Response to Disapproval 200 Area and 600 Area Vapor Intrusion Assessment Report

On June 18, 2018, NASA submitted the *200 Area and 600 Area Vapor Intrusion Assessment Report*. NMED disapproved the report on June 5, 2019 and directed NASA to respond to 12 comments and revise the assessment report by October 31, 2019. On October 7, 2019, NMED approved NASA's September 17, 2019 request for an extension to December 20, 2019.

In the September 17, 2019 request, NASA indicated that the response to several NMED comments was expected to be relatively complex. To address this complexity and complete final internal reviews of all comment responses, NASA requires additional time to submit the revised report. NASA hereby requests a further extension of time for submittal of the revised *200 Area and 600 Area Vapor Intrusion Assessment Report* from December 20, 2019 to February 3, 2020.
