HollyFrontier Navajo Refining LLC (Navajo) would like to rescind the *North Colony Landfarm Soil Sampling Work Plan* (2019 work plan) that was submitted on July 12, 2019, for the Navajo refinery in Artesia, New Mexico. The 2019 work plan is no longer required per the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) letter "Approval with Modifications, North Colony Landfarm (NCL) 2014 Soil Sampling Report, April 2015 and North Colony Landfarm 2014 Soil Sampling Statistically Significant Increase in Native Soil Concentrations – 90-day Demonstration Report, June 2015" dated July 19, 2019. The next work plan will be submitted on or before July 29, 2024, in accordance with the NMED July 19, 2019, letter.
