Dear Mr. Johnson,

This letter is in response to Public Service Company of New Mexico (**PNM**)'s request to modify PNM's Sampling and Analysis Plan at Person Generating Station for analytical method requirements. After review of the SW-846 Methods 601/8010 and 8240, we approve substitution of 601/8010 for 8240.

Also, regarding the issue of HRMB approval of proposed monitoring well locations discussed in our meeting January 25, 1993, the CAD states on the third page of Attachment B that location of monitoring wells will be subject to HRMB approval (attached). Prior to drilling, PNM must obtain this approval. We would also like the opportunity to review your planned well construction, drilling methods and the like.

In the past you have FAXed aerial photo maps to us showing proposed locations of monitoring wells. We would like this procedure continued for the proposed deep monitoring wells we discussed in our January 25, 1993 meeting in order to document approval. We would like at least one week notice prior to drilling.
