Based on the inspection the system is operating as proposed in the discharge plan, therefore, no corrections or additions are necessary at this time.

If PNM decides to convert the monitor wells on the east side of I-25 to recovery wells, a written request describing the number of wells to be converted, their location, proposed extraction rate and method of treatment and disposal should be submitted to NMED for approval before initiating any such changes. Upon receipt of PNM's request, NMED will determine if the proposal warrants a modification or an amendment to the plan.
